Midvale Baptist reaching people through Kids Best Camp



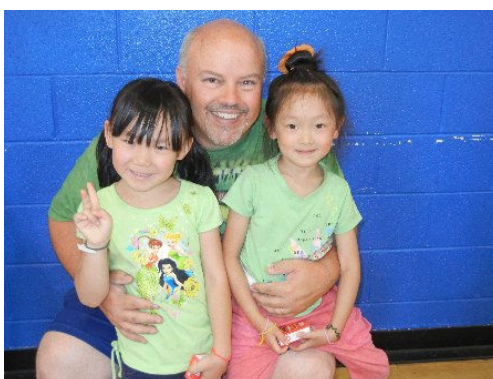
