Encountering the Nations Webinar Training in Review by Amanda Miller

Although the weather was frigid the morning of the training at Campus Community Church, we had a good turn out for a great start to focusing on the mission we have in our own communities to the nations. The first two hours were spent being trained by IMB Global Researcher, Bryan Galloway. For those who were new to the process, it proved very helpful in understanding who is here. We were also able to learn how to use the revamped peoplegroups.info website and learned the many added features to help with this mission ministry.

After the training was over, we ventured out into the cold weather for lunch at an ethnic restaurant. As we were walking down State Street in Madison, we noticed new ones and ones that were closed during construction, and we settled on a Mediterranean Cafe. We learned that the owner was first generation from Algeria but most of the workers were college students. His son also worked in the family business. We then went on to an Asian restaurant where most of the workers there that day were from Southeastern China and one from Thailand. We were able to build a relationship with our server that continues to this day.

All Pastors and Church Planters Invited to Count the Cost

One of the most effective leadership development workshops we have conducted in recent years is called "Count the Cost." Led by Bill Agee, Director of Church Planting at First Baptist Woodstock, the next workshop will be February 24-25 at Transformation Church in Sun Prairie. At that time, we will gather and develop a **Luke 14:28** process that will allow you to "Count the Cost" involved in fulfilling your vision and mission.

MARKIV CHURCH SOLUTIONS is a ministry designed to assist churches and church plants to look into the future and determine a strategic path to achieve their God given vision. The elements of **MARKIV** consist of the following:

- A church stewardship tool that allows a church or church plant to examine their current and projected income, spending tendencies, and growth patterns in light of the articulated and agreed upon vision. By knowing the tendencies and projections a church or church plant is able to see clearly where they will need assistance as well as where they are strong in fulfilling their vision.
- A church planting tool that serves as a roadmap for the church to grow through the various stages of development with strength and success. This element will cause the church to "Count the Cost" as they prepare to move forward with their ministry. This piece indicates the degree additional partners will need to participate, for how long, and at what point the new church will be able to stand on its own.
